1. Pascoe and Company, South Africa

The Emerald Legacy Necklace

Featuring a collection of fine, round Zambian emeralds started by Rayaz's father and completed 27 years later, it is a necklace as notable for its exquisite design as for the quality and rareness of the emeralds.

3. LAO Designs, Laos

This unique skirt originates in the Tai Neua area in the north of Laos. It is an outstanding example of intricate colored mat mi (ikhat technique) and supplementary weft woven in alternating bands. The birds, peacocks, are decorated with naga motifs, believed to protect the woman wearing the skirt.
