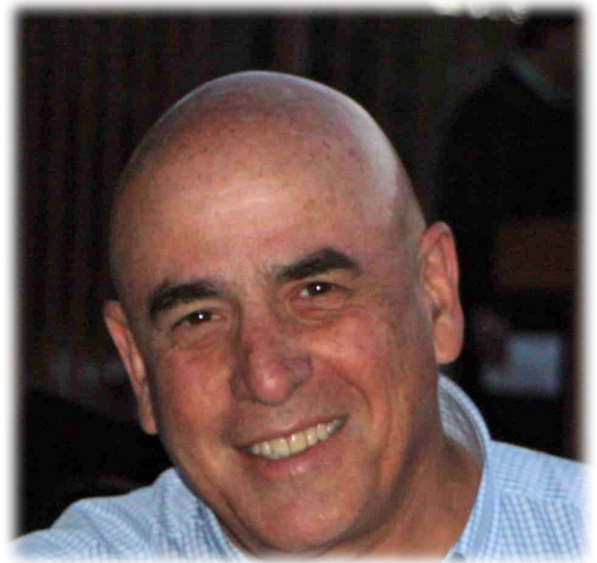
Uncovering unsolved mysteries through the eyes of historical artifacts-

The crash of the Hindenburg in 1937, and the fact that the cause has never been determined, forever changed the course of aviation.
