Baltimore, MD (October 28, 2022) – After two years of postponed events at the Baltimore Convention Center, the **Baltimore Art, Antique & Jewelry Show** made its triumphant return opening the show on Thursday, October 20th and concluded this past Sunday, October 23rd celebrating an incredible close to its 40th edition. For almost two years, the Baltimore Convention Center was transitioned for utilization as a field hospital to help alleviate the abundance of COVID-19 cases. Although they saw light use of the medical facilities, the hospital opted to remain open causing the Baltimore Show to be postponed in 2020 and 2021.

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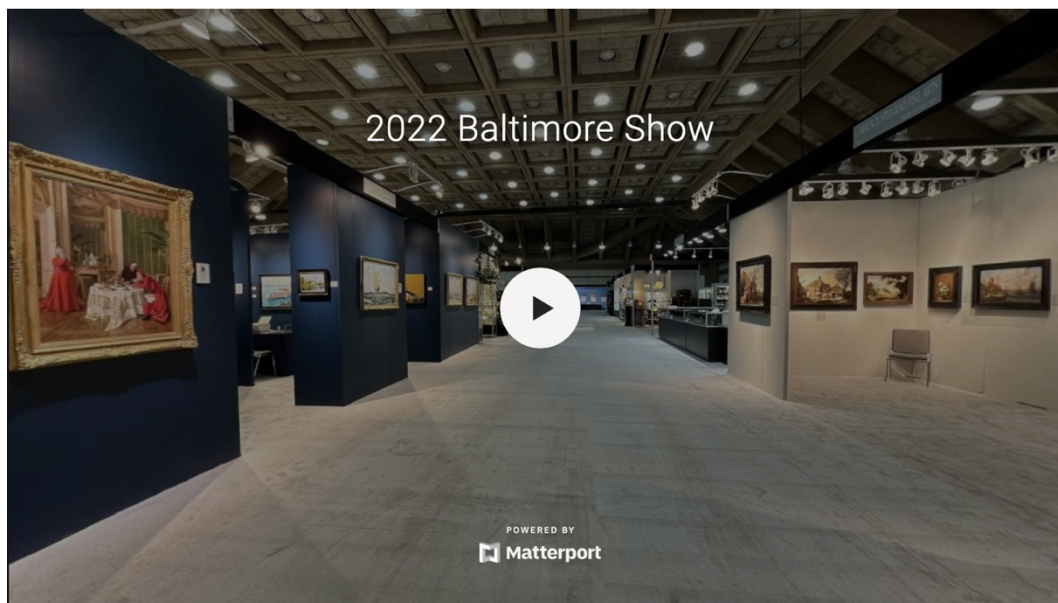
